After the Cap Canaille's overhang (almost 400 metres), navigation continues among the monumental cliffs, the Cosquer Cave and a rich variety of protected marine species.

- * Sailing through the Calanques Relaxing sailing through the Calanques, to admire and photograph the spectacular rock formations and the crystal clear waters.
- * Snorkeling and Swimming Stop for water activities in the most beautiful coves, such as Calanque de Sormiou or Calanque de En-Vau






Bandol and Le Lavandou, Sail in the wind for the Iles d'Or!



- * Night in Bandol Continue toward Bandol for a quiet night in this lovely harbour.
 - The city of Bandol is known for its vineyards that rise in the steep mountain on the sea, for the typical wines of Provence and for the very fine fresh catch.
 - The beaches are different, pebble or sand, the coast is varied and for those who want to have fun and play there is the Grand Casino Partouche overlooking the sea.
- ★ Day 3 from Bandol to Le Lavandou

- * Evening walk along the promenade and dinner in a good local restaurant.

The Îles d'Hyères, the Golden Islands. Porquerolles

- * Day 4 Îles d'Hyères, the Golden Islands already known by the ancient Greeks as Ligystidi ("Ligurian Islands), make up a small extraordinary archipelago with the famous Porquerolles, with enchanting landscapes, crystal clean waters, small villages. In Occitan the Golden Islands are called Illas d'Ieras.

 Since ancient times, from Plinio il Vecchio to the Provençal poets, they have been "sung" for their original charm.
 - * Route to the Îles d'Hyères. Early morning departure to discover the Golden Islands.
 - * Arrival in Porquerolles. The island is the best known of the archipelago, and has a protected natural heritage (Conservatoire Botanique National Méditerranéen de Porquerolles).
 - * Anchoring in the turquoise waters or landing at the marina, in the small village of Porquerolles, with free time to explore the island on foot or by bike
 - * Dinner on board or in the village Dinner prepared on board, enjoying the tranquility of the night, the scents of the sea, the island and the starry sky. Alternatively, in a typical restaurant in the village.







 - * Relaxing Evening We return to the yacht for a pleasant evening on board, surrounded by nature and landscape, for great relaxation..
- * Day 6 from Port-Cros to the Anse de Méjean. In the Bay of Toulon, a secret and typical of the Var Coast, this pebble cove welcomes you under the pine cliffs, with the few fishermen's houses, for a magical and unknown moment between colors, seents, cicadas singing and the sound of the waves.



- * Route to the Anse de Méjean Quiet navigation to one of the most unknown and evocative corners of this beautiful coast
- * Relaxation Day A day dedicated to relaxation, swimming and discovering the surrounding beaches and small bays


